## 1. REVIEW

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“The Lord” is mentioned six times in these verses. How can Christ-followers live in such a way that all we say and do with others is for the Lord?

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## 2. ASSESS

Reflect on the six points from the message. Which one challenged you most? Why?

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Which relationship reviewed in this message needs your attention most? On a scale of 1-10, how would you rate that relationship?

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How you view your role (as a spouse, parent, employee, leader) affects how you relate with the ones you're doing that part of life with. What are your recent interactions revealing about how you view that role?
