1. REVIEW

Why is it so important that we choose to serve the Lord daily? What's at stake?

2. ASSESS

Evaluate your choice and commitment in serving the Lord. How would you describe that to your small group?

3. APPLY

Our church is filled with godly men serving God and leading their families. Give encouragement to those in your group right now (or write a note to those who exemplify this if applicable).

Challenge yourselves to increase your service and commitment to the Lord. What will you do this week to make it happen?
